

sgapiGetValueLabel(%questionID,%language)

This function returns the answer option title of the selected answer option (or null, if not answered). For single-select questions, a single value is returned. Multi-select and matrix questions will return an array.

Using the %language parameter you can return the title in the given language. The values are the languages available in the translation menu. %language must be title case.

Examples

In this example, we return the answer option label(s) of a likert scale question using sgapiGetValue() and sgapiPrint_R().

%%output .= sgapiGetValueLabel(2);
```

Take a Likert Scale question with the following labels and reporting values:

- Very Dissatisfied | 1
- Dissatisfied | 2
- Neutral | 3
- Satisfied | 4
- Very Satisfied | 5

The output would be: Very Satisfied

In this example, the following code will output the option title in the language of your choice.

```
//single select (hard coded) to pull Spanish
%%source_Question_Id = 5;
%%output = sgapiGetValueLabel(%%source_Question_Id, 'Spanish');
```

%%source_Question_Id = 5: This will be your source question. Just replace 5 with your Question ID.

To specify a language, replace **Spanish** (within the single quotes) to your preferred language.
