

sgapiStr_Replace(%%search,%%replace,%%subject)

This is equivalent to [str_replace](#) function in PHP. This function looks for %%search inside of %%subject and replaces all %%search values with %%replace.

The %%search attribute can be a single value or an array of values. If %%search is an array, then the search and replace is performed with every entry of subject, and the return value is an array as well.

Examples

The below example will return "SrvyGzm Rcks!"

```
%%subject = 'SurveyGizmo Rocks!';
%%vowels = array('a','e','i','o','u','A','E','I','O','U');

%%output .= sgapiStr_Replace(%%vowels, %%replace='', %%subject);
```

The below example will return get the value from question ID 3, which is a list of textboxes, and will return the array of the values with the vowels removed.

%%subject = sgapiGetValue(3);
%%vowels = array('a','e','i','o','u','A','E','I','O','U');

%%output .= sgapiPrint_R(sgapiStr_Replace(%%vowels, %%replace='',
%%subject));
```
