

sgapiDate(%format, %time)

This is equivalent to the [date](#) function in PHP. This function converts %%time, a Unix timestamp, into a human readable date and time. %%time is optional and defaults to the current time.

Check out the PHP documentation for this function to learn more about options for %%format.

Example

This works just like the php date() function.

```
%%format = "Y-m-d H:i:s";
%%output .= sgapiDate(%format);

//outputs the current time in this format: 2011-10-28 12:50:45
```
