

# sgapiPrint\_R(%%mixed)

This is equivalent to the [print\\_r](#) function in PHP. Given any variable sgapiPrint\_R will display information about a variable in a way that is readable by humans. Use with %%output to output to the page. Very useful when looking at arrays of data or objects.

In this example, we return the value(s) of a checkbox question using sgapiGetValue() and sgapiPrint\_R()
