

sgapiArray_Rand(%%array,%%number)

This function is the equivalent of the [array_rand](#) function in PHP. Picks one or more random entries out of an array, and returns the key (or keys) of the random entries.

%%arr = the defined array.

%%number = the number of returned array items.

Example

```
%%arr = array('a','b','c','d','e'); //Defines the items you'd like in  
your array  
%%out = sgapiArray_Rand(%%arr,2); //Return two random items  
%%output .= %%out[1];
```
