

Make An Image Appear For A Specified Amount of Time

We do not have a built-in feature for making an image disappear after a certain amount of time. This JavaScript will allow you to only show an image for a certain amount of time.

This workaround works for most of our customers in most cases but may require some tweaking to get it right. If you have a solution that works better let us know!

Setup

First add your [image element](#) that you'd like to disappear after a certain time period. Next click **Add New Action > JavaScript**. Name your action and click **Save Action and Edit**. Now paste the below code.

```
window.setTimeout("document.getElementById('sgE-2035686-1-2-image').style.display='none';", 3000)
```

Customizations

Element ID - First change the yellow highlighted element ID above to your image's element ID. To learn how to find your element ID check out our tutorial on [Finding Element IDs](#).

Timeout - Next set up how long you want your image to show for. To do this change the green 3000 above to your preferred timeout. Currently 3000 is the timeout for three seconds. This metric is measured by milliseconds. An easy way to calculate this is to times the number of seconds you'd like the image to show for by 1000.
