

# Change Text of a Button on a Specific Page

You can change the text of a Next, Back and Submit buttons just by adding a little JavaScript!

1. Click the **Add New Action** button on the bottom of the page where you wish to change the button.
2. Select **Javascript**.
3. Name/Describe your **JavaScript** action (this is helpful so that you can identify later what the action is doing).
4. Click **Save Action and Edit**.
5. Paste one of the below codes:

To change the Next button, paste the below code and replace 'What?' with 'WhateverYouWantYourButtonToRead' and you are all set!

```
$(document).ready(function() {  
    $('#sg_NextButton').val('What?');  
});
```

To change the Back button, paste the below code and replace 'What?' with 'WhateverYouWantYourButtonToRead' and you are all set!

```
$(document).ready(function() {  
    $('#sg_BackButton').val('What?');  
});
```

To change the Submit button, paste the below code and replace 'What?' with 'WhateverYouWantYourButtonToRead' and you are all set!

```
$(document).ready(function() {  
    $('#sg_SubmitButton').val('What?');  
});
```
